**COURSE CLASSIFICATION DESCRIPTION/ ROOM ASSIGNMENTS**

**\*Asynchronous Online Learning**

A course where all of the content is delivered online and students can participate in the online course from **anywhere and anytime**. There are no real time online or face-to-face meetings, unless indicated otherwise.

**\*\*Synchronous Online Learning : ZOOM**

A course where most of the content is delivered online and students can participate in courses from anywhere. There are real-time online meetings and students login from anywhere but **at the same time to participate in the course**.

**Bi-Chronous:** A course with a combination of face-to-face and asynchronously online delivery with a portion of the course delivered online.

**Hybrid**

A combination of face-to-face and synchronously online students in the course.
